Veterans Choice

In August 2014, President Obama signed into law the <u>Veterans Access</u>, <u>Choice and Accountability Act (VACAA) of 2014</u>, which directed the establishment of a <u>new program</u> to better meet the health care needs of our nation's Veterans.

The law directs the establishment of a <u>Veterans Choice Card benefit</u> that allows <u>eligible Veterans</u> who live more than 40 miles from a VA facility or are unable to get a VA appointment within 30 days of their preferred date, or are within 30 days of the date determined medically necessary by their physicians, to obtain approved care in their community instead.
